SUBJECT: RESOLUTION 2020-08 - Establishing the tentative Millage Rate for Fiscal Year 2020/2021

BACKGROUND:

Pursuant to Florida Statutes, the City has received Form DR-420, Certification of Taxable Value from the Pinellas County Property Appraiser.

In order for the Property Appraiser to mail out TRIM notices the City Commission is required to set a tentative millage rate.

The tentative millage rate is recommended to be 1.8326 mills. The Finance Director advises that the current rolled back rate would be 1.7323 based on the proposed valuation of \$ 1,334,284,367 for the City of Indian Rocks Beach. With an adopted millage rate of 1.8326 for FY 2020/21, an additional \$137,220.00 ad valorem tax revenue will be collected over current year collections.

ANALYSIS:

Pursuant to Chapter 200.065 (4) (d) F.S., once the tentative millage rate is set, in no event may the final millage rate that is adopted in September exceed the millage rate tentatively adopted, however it may be lower.

MOTION:

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF INDIAN ROCKS BEACH, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING THE TENTATIVE MILLAGE RATE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020/2021; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to s.200.065(4)(b) F.S., the City is required to advise the Property Appraiser of Pinellas County of the tentative millage rate and the date, time and place of the First Public Hearing to adopt the Budget and Millage Rate for Fiscal Year 2020/21.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Indian Rocks Beach, Florida, that the tentative millage rate be 1.8326 for Fiscal Year 2020/21.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the first public hearing to consider the tentative millage rate and the tentative 2020/21 Budget will be held on Tuesday, September 3, 2020 at 6:00 p.m., in the City Commission Chambers, 1507 Bay Palm Boulevard, Indian Rocks Beach, Florida, where all interested parties may appear and address the City Commission on these issues.
