Sealed bids will be received at the City of Indian Rocks Beach, City Hall Complex, 1507 Bay Palm Boulevard, Indian Rocks Beach, Florida, 33785, in Pinellas County, **until 2:00 P.M., E.S.T. April 4, 2018**, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud in the Civic Auditorium Conference Room, Indian Rocks Beach, Florida, for furnishing necessary labor, materials, incidental items, and equipment for the **CITY OF INDIAN ROCKS BEACH – KEEGAN CLAIR PARK – LANDSCAPING AND PARKING ENHANCEMENTS PROJECT- Bid # I.R.B.P.S.D. – 2018-2**. There will be a non-mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting held on March 20, 2018, 2018 @ 11:00 A.M. E.S.T.in the Civic Auditorium Conference Room, 1507 Bay Palm Boulevard, Indian Rocks Beach, FL 33785.

Electronic Bidding Documents may be obtained from Dean A. Scharmen, Public Services Director, via email request to dscharmen@irbcity.com. Last day to request information is March 28, 2018 at 2:00 P.M., E.S.T. Sealed bids must be submitted on bid forms as provided marked **CITY OF INDIAN ROCKS BEACH – KEEGAN CLAIR PARK – LANDSCAPING AND PARKING ENHANCEMENTS PROJECT - Bid # I.R.B.P.S.D. – 2018-2**.

All bids must be accompanied by a certified check, bank draft, or bid bond in the amount of five percent (5%) of the base bid, made payable to the City of Indian Rocks Beach. Said check, bank draft or bid bond shall guarantee that should the bid be accepted, the bidder, will, within then (10) days after the acceptance of the bid, enter into a contract with the City of Indian Rocks Beach for the services proposed to be performed and will at that time furnish performance and payment bonds each in the amount of 100 percent (100%) of the contract, made payable to the City of Indian Rocks Beach, Florida, which bonds shall be adequate to guarantee the faithful performance of the contract.

Bids may be withdrawn prior to the date of opening, but no bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days after the date of the opening of bids.

Bids must conform to the specifications and instruction to Bidders. The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any technical defects, and to accept any bid which the bidding authority believes to be in the best interest of the City. This request for bids and all bids submitted are subject to the City Ordinances.

A person or affiliate who has been placed on the convicted vendor list following a conviction for a public entity crime may not submit a bid on a contract to provide any goods or services to a public entity, may not submit a bid on a contract with a public entity for the construction or repair of a public building or public work, may not submit bids on leases of real property to a public entity, may not be awarded or perform work as a contractor, supplier, subcontractor, or consultant under a contract with any public entity, and may not transact business with any public entity in excess of the threshold amount provided in Section 287.017, for CATEGORY TWO for a period of 36 months from the date of being placed on the convicted vendor list.

Non-conformance with these instructions is grounds for rejection of bid. Late bids will be rejected.
