**PRESS RELEASE
CITY OF INDIAN ROCKS BEACH ANNOUNCES
ADVISORY BOARD VACANCIES**

The City of Indian Rocks Beach currently has vacancies on the Planning & Zoning Board and the Board of Adjustments and Appeals.

The ***Board of Adjustments and Appeals*** consists of 5 regular board members and 2 alternate board members appointed by the City Commission, and whenever possible, shall consist of an engineer, a real estate broker, a businessperson and an architect. The term of office is 3 years and no member shall serve more than 2 consecutive three-year terms. The duties and responsibilities of the board include:

Recommend authorization, upon appeal in specific cases, to such variance from the terms of the City's land development regulations as will not be contrary to the public interest such as Special Exceptions and Administrative Appeals.

The ***Planning and Zoning Board*** consists of 7 regular members and 2 alternate members appointed by the City Commission and whenever possible, shall consist of an engineer, a real estate broker, a businessperson and an architect. The term of office is 2 years. *A financial disclosure is required.* The duties and responsibilities of the Board include:

The P&Z Board shall have advisory powers but shall have no authority to make binding recommendations, however, the Board can review and recommend approval or disapproval of site plans, zoning amendments and planned unit developments (PUDs) when such is required by the zoning ordinance.
