Keegan Clair Park Reopens



The City of Indian Rocks Beach is pleased to announce the reopening of Keegan Clair Park, located at Miami Avenue and 2nd Street, after undergoing extensive park improvements.

Enhancements include new landscaping, sidewalks, solar, parking for vehicles and golf carts and a sand volleyball court. The new parking lot is closed from 1:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m.

The sand volleyball court was installed at a cost of \$9,385 and was sponsored by the IRB Homeowners' Association. The volleyball court is available on a first come, first served basis and play is limited to one (1) hour if others are waiting. Players should bring their own volleyball and a rake to level out the sand after play.
