## FLOOD MAPS ARE CHANGING Your Flood Insurance Rates and Requirements May Be Affected

**Your property is located in a flood zone**, which may be low, moderate, or high flood risk. If your property is going into a high risk zone on the updated map, flood insurance may be required if you carry a mortgage, but you may be eligible to grandfather in your current rate. If your risk is decreasing, your rate may be reduced. If you are in a low or moderate risk flood zone, take advantage of a highly reduced preferred risk policy.
