The library opened November 16, 1974! Happy 50th birthday to the library! The library was built with the help of the Friends of the Library and the City of Indian Rocks Beach. Over 200 volunteers built the collection and shelves. Many people contributed money, materials and their labor to the library. Margaret Olson was the first president of the Friends of the Library in 1974. Volunteers are always welcome. Pick up an application at the library or on the library web page.

Over 2000 people are members of the library. There are over 20,000 items in the library to check out, including books, games, puzzles and ukuleles!

The library is still managed by 20 volunteers and a professional librarian.

The Library has a book store with a great selection of trending fiction and non-fiction. The library volunteers manage the bookstore. Donations are always welcome.



You can use the library wifi for free. You can use our library computers for free, you can get a library card for free. If you are not a resident, you can still get a card for a nominal fee.

You can join the library's On the Rocks book club that meets on the last Tuesday of the month. You can attend story time at 11:30 AM in the children's area. In June and July you can attend a summer reading program including Reading with the Rays to get tickets to a game!

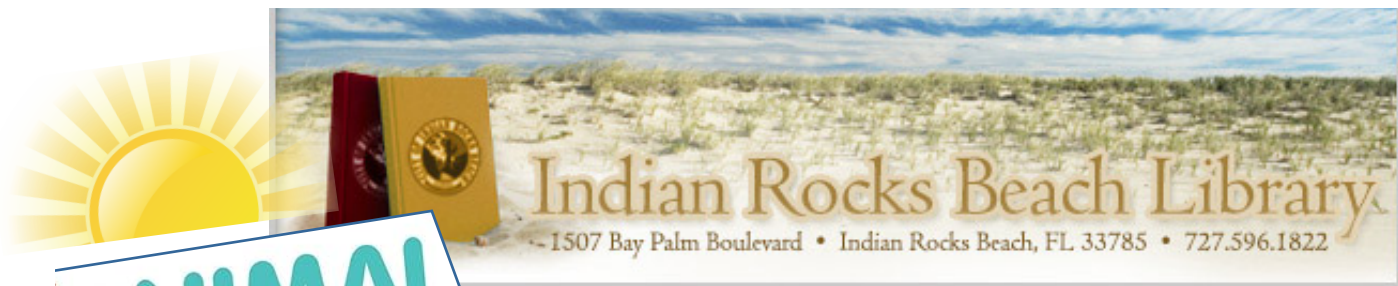

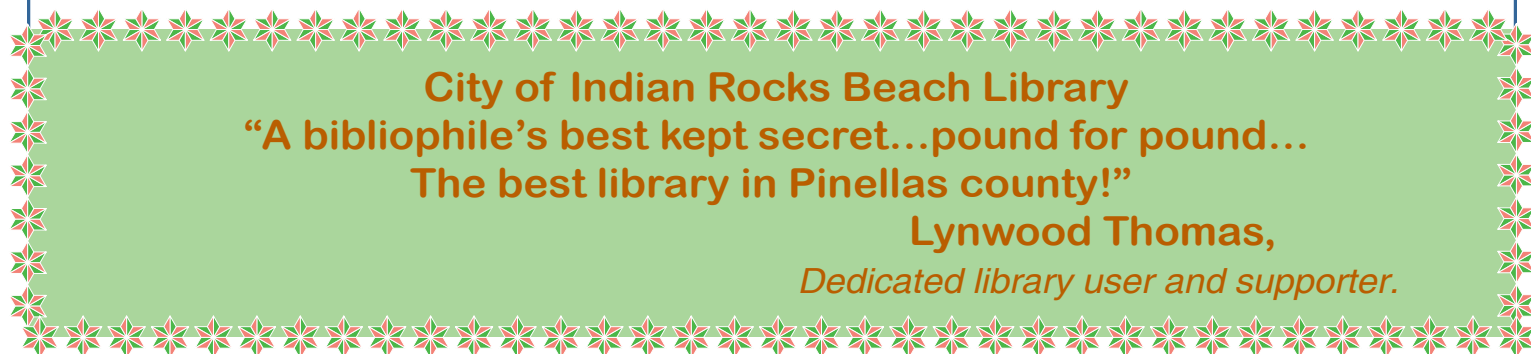

For the benefit of all residents as well as our visitors, the City of Indian Rocks Beach is committed to neighborhood maintenance and upkeep. In an effort to keep IRB beautiful we would like to make you aware of some property maintenance city ordinances. Our goals are to develop and establish standards that ensure positive effects on property value and community appearance.

Working together we can achieve these goals.

- All vehicles on residential property must be in running condition and have current tags.
- Boats, trailers, and campers must have current tags, and vessels must have current FI numbers.
- Openly storing lumber, building materials, appliances, auto parts, trash and debris, etc. is prohibited.
- Grass should be no higher than 6", weeds, bushes and trees must be kept trimmed.
- Trash and recycle carts should be placed at curbside after 7:00 PM the night before scheduled pickup and removed from curb by 7:00 pm on the day of collection. All trash must fit in trash carts. No loose trash bags are permitted.

In an effort to clean-up and beautify our neighborhoods the Indian Rocks Beach Code Compliance Department will continue enhanced enforcement of these ordinances. If you have any questions or concerns please feel free to call the City of Indian Rocks
